The Day my Life was Changed!

"Daughter, come back! Daughter, come back!"

That was my mother calling me as I got into my sister's car and went <u>speeding</u> down the road. I planned to drive the car off the road and *take my own life*.

I was a medical student but had to quit school because I was not well. I was so sick that everyone thought I was going to die. My boyfriend *broke up with me* because of this. Then my university told me that I could not return to study because my grades were not good enough. I had lots of problems and felt that *my life was falling apart*. I felt no one cared about me.

Because of my problems, I was unable to sleep at night. I would lock myself in my room and *pace the floor*. I would not share with anyone, especially my mother, what was going on in my heart. Now I was going to *commit suicide* and get away from all these problems.

I was almost at the place where I was going to drive the car off the road to kill myself. Suddenly I heard a loud BANG! I could not *control* the car and it almost *tipped over*. I got out and saw a big hole in the right front tire.



I began to cry. I knew that God was speaking to me. He had stopped the car by having the tire explode. He had stopped me just before I drove off the road and over the cliff. I knew that He knew where I was and what I was planning to do. I knew that He cared for me. There beside my sister's car, I prayed to God. I gave my life to Him and asked Him to be my guide each day, *for the rest of my life*.



That night, I did not lock my bedroom door nor pace the floor. I found my Bible and began reading it. I read about God and about Jesus. That night was a *turning point* in my life. I was never the same after that.
