The Rich Man Who had Everything - but did not have Peace! (Easy)

1. One day, a young <u>Jewish leader</u> ran up to Jesus. <u>He got down on his knees</u> in front of Jesus. The young man had a question that he wanted to ask Jesus. He had a problem in his life and he wanted Jesus to help him.

"Good Teacher, what can I do to have a life that has meaning and peace?" he asked Jesus.

2. "Why do you call Me good?" Jesus asked. "There is only One who is really good and that is God." Then Jesus talked to the young man about the <u>Jewish 10 commandments</u>: "<u>Do not murder</u>. <u>Do not commit adultery</u>. Do not steal. Do not lie. <u>Do not cheat</u>. <u>Treat your father and your</u> <u>mother with respect</u>. Do these things and you will have a life with meaning."



3. When the young man heard the list of commandments Jesus <u>recited</u> to him, he said, "I have tried to obey all these commandments since I was a young boy. <u>What is still lacking in my life</u>? Why don't I have peace? <u>What keeps me from having peace in my heart</u>?"

Jesus looked at the young man and loved him. He cared about the young man and the needs in his life.

4. "One thing is <u>missing</u> in your life," Jesus said. "Here is what you need to do:
Go, sell everything you have and give the money to the poor. Your life
and heart will change and you will have real <u>riches that will last forever</u>
- in heaven. Then come and follow Me and walk the same road with Me."



5. When the young man heard Jesus' words, he became very sad. He walked away from Jesus with a <u>heavy heart</u> because he was a very rich man and what Jesus told him to do was very difficult for him to do. But he knew that his money could not buy peace or happiness in his heart. He went away with lots to think about.



6. Jesus knew the young man was very <u>selfish</u>. He had a lot of money and nice things. He was a leader and people did what he told them to do. But Jesus knew that he would never have peace in his heart unless he changed and began to <u>think of and care for others instead of</u> <u>think only about himself</u>. If he gave to others, then he could follow Jesus. Jesus lived His life as He taught others they should live, and was always caring for those around Him.

Will the young man do what Jesus told him to do? We don't know! The Bible does not tell us the end of this story.

The Rich Man Who Had Everything - But Peace - Guidelines for Teachers - (Easy)

<u>Lesson Aims</u>: To stimulate thought about peace and life that has meaning and purpose To help students begin to think about what kind of a man Jesus was when He advised this rich young ruler as He did

To help students feel comfortable as they study this conversation Jesus had with the young man

Lesson Outline:

- 1. Read through the story together: (35 minutes)
- 2. Answer the comprehension questions: (35 minutes)
- 3. Something to Think About and English Conversation Practice: (20 minutes) (depending on the ability and willingness of your group)
 - a. List what the young man had: List what he did not have:
 - b. What do you think the young man will do next? (Possible answers: go away and do a lot of thinking, perhaps ask others for advice, forget everything that Jesus said and just go on as before without peace, keep seeking to know peace by doing good things, he might do as Jesus said because he believed what Jesus told him.) What do you think is the end of the story?
 - c. You are the young man's friend. What advice would you give him?
 - d. How can we find peace and life with meaning today? How important is it to have these in our lives?
