YOU'RE SPECIAL ENGLISH CAMP SAMPLE SCHEDULE FOR TEACHING SESSIONS

It is hard to determine how long each of these various sections will actually take. It depends a lot on the English level of the students and how the leader leads the group. Some items may go quicker and others take more time than allotted. Just keep watching your time.

You will probably not have enough time to make use of all the material provided on our topic, "You're Special!" There is far more material than you can use, so you will need to decide what you want to get across to your students and that will help you decide what you can use and what you leave out.

Note: Session #1 and Session #2 can be used in reverse order if you prefer to teach about God's creation first before teaching about "You're Special".
